York University posts top scores in Times Higher Education Global Impact Ranking

This year, York has placed 11th in Canada and 67th overall against 1,115 post-secondary institutions from 94 different countries. The THE Impact Rankings are the only global performance tables that assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. Markham Centre Campus community update

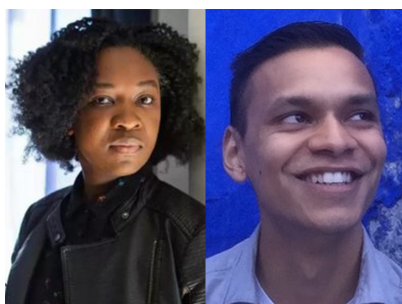
